

Letters to the editor

Up to 250 words in response to a published article in a **recent** issue (ie published within the last 4 months) of *The Clinical Teacher*.

Format

- Each Letter to the Editor should be maximum 250 words. A structured summary is not required for these articles.
- Up to 4 references are permitted in the Vancouver Style (these are not included in the total word count).
- No figures or tables are permitted.
- References should be set out according to the format recommended by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (Vancouver Guidelines). Authors should retain a copy of the manuscript and any tables or figures.
- The manuscript should be double-spaced with a wide margin (at least 3 cm) on either side. The writing should be clear and concise and we encourage the use of short sentences and the active voice.

Submission

- Authors should upload a full version of the manuscript including a title page with author and corresponding author details.
