References must be in Vancouver style and up to 2 tables or figures are

permissible. Authors are warned that Cross-cutting edge papers are aimed at a very particular niche, which is to make cutting edge research (empirical findings and theory) that is relevant to but generally published outside of health professions education journals (i.e., cross-cutting) accessible to the readership of *Medical Education*.
